All what is necessary for indepth understanding and accepted agreements between stakeholders

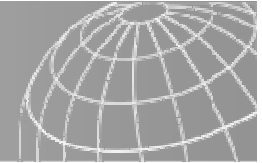
- Quantitative information and data

What is PROSPECT?

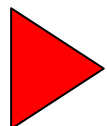
- PROSPECT is an innovative approach to interactive and region specific labor market monitoring (reference: Germany)
- The key goal is to contribute to transparent, efficient and interactive matching & placement mechanisms

What are the benefits?

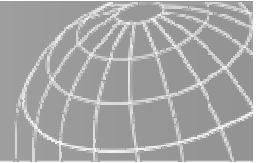
- Availability of specific labor market information in a region
- Increased transparency, acceptance and efficiency
- All regional stakeholders benefit (e.g. companies, job seekers, service providers and learning facilitators)

How does the approach work?

- Continuous dialogue involving regional stakeholders
 - related to process of acquiring regional LM information
 - on conclusions and recommendations
- Continuous monitoring to efficiently gain information on the current situation and future trends of regional labor market



It is intended by MKI-vetEP to adapt and test PROSPECT following the approach of a joint action learning process.
